4th International biennale of children's drawings

Dear Art teacher(s),

We are very proud to inform you that Primary school Božidar Jakac, Ljubljana, Slovenia, has decided to organize the "4th International biennale of children's drawings" in order to commemorate the name, life work and memory of great Slovenian artist Božidar Jakac.

The contest is intended for primary school pupils in Slovenia and abroad. It will be divided into three different age groups:

1st group: pupils from the age of 6 to 8 years

2nd group: pupils from the age of 9 to 11 years

3rd group: pupils from the age of 12 to 14 years

Each school can participate with one drawing in every age group. The first selection will be made by the school art teachers which are kindly asked to send us three preselected drawings.

A title of this contest is called "DRAWING - a dot, a line..." A theme and a technique are not predetermined. Drawings shouldn't exceed the A3 format. Every individual drawing should include the following information:

- Author's name and surname,
- Author's class or the age group,
- Drawing's title,
- Mentor's name and surname,
- Mentor's e-mail address and
- the school's address.

All drawings will be carefully examined by a three member board of experts. The main criteria regarding the drawings' evaluation will be children's creativity.

The best three drawings in each individual category will be given a prize with symbolic gift.
